CRICHTON-MCCORMICK PARK

§101. RULES AND REGULATIONS.

The following rules and regulations are hereby established for the protection of Crichton-McCormick Park, owned by the Borough of Portage and located in said Borough, hereinafter designated "the park":

- A. The park shall be closed to the public from the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. [Ord. 4-1980]
- B. No person shall injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any of the trees, plants, shrubs, turf, buildings, structures or fixtures therein, or any other property of the Borough located within the park.
- C. No person shall conduct himself within the park so as to annoy any other person using the park for recreational purposes.
- D. No person shall set up any booth, table or stand for the sale of any article whatsoever within the limits of the park without the consent of the Borough, which shall have authority to refuse such consent in any instance.
- E. No person shall dispose of any waste or garbage in the park except in receptacles designed for the respective purpose. All persons using the park shall dispose of all waste and garbage left by them in such proper receptacles.
- F. No person shall injure, deface or destroy any notice, rule or regulation posted at any place within the park by authority of the Borough or any other authority of the Borough. Nor shall any person post, at any place within the park, any notice or placard other than by authority of the Borough.
- G. No person shall set or maintain any fire in the park except in charcoal grills or stoves; or in fireplaces maintained for that purpose and located by the authority of the Borough.
- H. No person shall bring or consume any spirituous liquor, wine, malt or brewed beverages in the park.

- J. No person shall wash, wax or polish any motor vehicle in the park.

- K. No owner, custodian or keeper of an animal shall allow such animal to run at large at any time within the park, unless accompanied by and under the immediate control of such owner, custodian or keeper.

§102. PENALTIES.

1. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed \$600 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense.
2. In addition to the penalties provided herein, the Borough may recover penalties, damages, costs, reasonable attorney's fees, court costs, court reporter's fees and other expenses of litigation by appropriate suite at law against the person or user found to have violated this Part.
